

# BEV'S SCARF IDEA

## 1. KNIT a SCARF

These are not rigid measurements and instructions for making a scarf – just an idea

Yarn: Use something thick and soft e.g. with mohair content  
Stitch: Tuck lace e.g. Singer card 2 using every 2<sup>nd</sup> needle  
Tension: Loose  
Width: Approximately 30cm  
Length: From the machine bed to the floor and back  
Machine: Bulky or mid gauge

## 2. JOIN the ENDS



Join end AB to side part CD

Point A joins point C

Point B joins point D

Note: The join can be done on the machine before casting off the stitches or after casting off and away from the machine.

## 3. WEAR YOUR SCARF WITH STYLE
